PARTICIPATION GUIDELINES

Parents entering this program commit to fulfilling the above required components. Attendance is taken at each meeting. Each family is allotted no more than 3 *unexcused* absences for the year (we will be generous with what is excused). Please communicate to the PCL when an absence is necessary.

ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL (HYBRID)

Parents will walk children to their class and pick them up at the door of the classroom when classes have dismissed. Please be prompt to arrive with your child/ren and be present for the parent meeting before start time. Children can arrive in class no more than ten minutes before class start time. Do not leave your child in class if an adult is not yet present.

STUDENT CONDUCT

- ❖ Be punctual and prepared for class.
- ❖ Be courteous and considerate of others. Allow everyone an opportunity to speak.
- ❖ Be cooperative and participate in class and prayer.
- ❖ Use language and actions expressive of Christian behavior.
- ❖ Do not bring food or snacks. We have students with severe allergies.
- ❖ Do not bring toys, electronic devices, weapons, or illegal substances.
- ❖ Cell phones must be turned off and put away for the duration of class time.
- ❖ Dress appropriately: no short skirts or short shorts, revealing or offensive clothing.
- ❖ In church: Be respectful of the Lord's house. Observe silence when appropriate.

CHILD PROTECTION CATECHESIS

The Archdiocese of New Orleans has implemented a mandatory policy on the teaching of Child Protection and Safe Environment to all teachers, volunteers, and students. Parents who wish to opt out of training for their children must sign a form indicating so before the training class in September. Training materials are available for review on the Safe Environment page of the Archdiocese of New Orleans website. The parish catechetical staff has a moral and legal duty to comply with the law to ensure the welfare of a child. Pursuant to State Law, we are required to report suspected child abuse, and we will also follow diocesan policy on such matters.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION

First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion are usually completed in second grade. In addition to Family Catechesis, candidates and their parents attend sacramental preparation classes on the fourth Sunday of each month from 4:30-5:30 pm. A calendar of these events is received at registration. A sacramental prep fee is charged to cover the cost of the sacramental preparation books, retreat, and reception.

Confirmation preparation is completed in eleventh grade. Confirmation prep classes are held on Sundays from 7-8 pm. Candidates attend a Confirmation retreat, complete a service project, and undergo an interview shortly before Confirmation. The sacramental prep fee includes retreat, gown rental, and reception.
